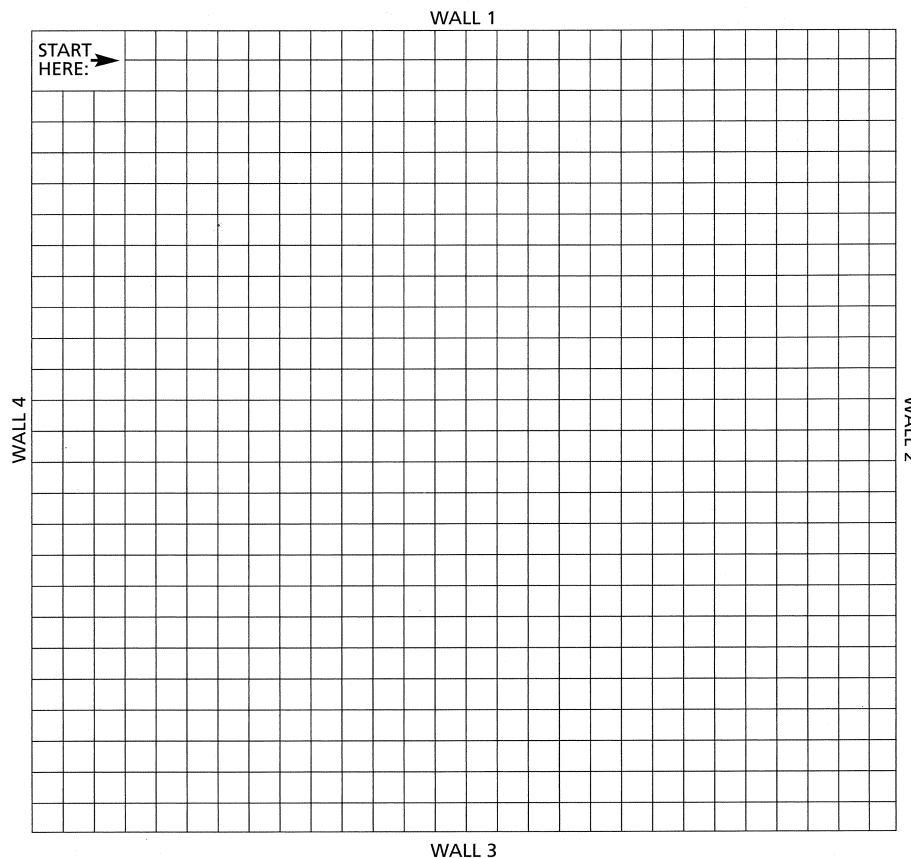


## How to measure your kitchen.

1. Draw a basic sketch of the room.
2. Start in the left corner of the wall with the window and sink. Measure the entire length of the wall over to the right corner.
3. Now go back and measure from the left corner to the outside edge of the window trim.
4. Measure the window opening from trim to trim (outside edges).
5. Continue measuring from the outside edge of the trim to the next opening or to the right corner of the wall. The total measurement of these individual sections should be the same as your overall measurement of the wall.
6. Repeat the process for the remaining walls.
7. Now measure height.
8. For windows, measure from the floor to the bottom of the sill.
9. Measure from the bottom of the sill to the top of the window trim.
10. Measure from the top of the window trim to the ceiling.
11. For doors, measure from the floor to the top of the trim.
12. Measure from the top of the trim to the ceiling.
13. Indicate on your diagram the swing direction for all doors.
14. Now measure the height and depth of bulkheads (if any). It's the space between the top of the cabinets and the ceiling.
15. Measure and list all appliances on a separate sheet.
16. On the diagram, indicate the locations of all outlets, wall switches, pipes, drains and gas lines.
